**Hudson Opera House presents *Between The River and The Sky*,
an Exhibition of New Works by Vincent Pomilio**

HUDSON - The Hudson Opera House presents an exhibition of new works by Vincent Pomilio opening Saturday, October 4. There will an opening reception with the artist on Saturday, October 4 from 6 to 8 p.m. The exhibition will be on display at the Opera House through November 1.

Between The River and The Sky, is an exhibition of new work that explores the boundaries between the natural world and the abstract. Vincent Pomilio primarily works in all painting media, on canvas, paper, or wooden panel. For the past ten years his work has been largely abstract, always using the Natural World as his guide. The image evolves through a series of layers, each one rubbed, sanded, or burnished with tools. The image then reveals itself and he intuitively knows when to bring it to completion.

Some of his work has a strong landscape feeling as in *Between The River and The Sky*. Vincent always encourages the viewer to find recognizable shapes and images in his work. "If you see it, it is there". Most of these paintings have an all-over feeling as if these self-organizing systems continue off the picture plane. Vincent Pomilio's career as a painter spans over 25 years. His work is owned by private collectors and corporations throughout the United States and Europe.
